STATEMENT OF COMMITMENT

Please realize that by auditioning you are making a commitment to be available for this production's rehearsals and performances. Rehearsals will be after school from 3:30 - 6:30 pm. Some Saturday rehearsals may be necessary as well. You will be called at times for the full rehearsal period, and at other times just for parts of the rehearsal period. We will work hard not to waste your time and in turn we ask that you do not waste our time. DO NOT audition for this show if you are not going to commit yourself to the show 110%.

After something is taught, such as music and choreography, you will be expected to have it memorized for the next rehearsal. So, you will need to practice at home and not use just the rehearsal period. Your lines for the play must me memorized on the days they are due. We don't have time to waste and expect everyone to be ready for every rehearsal. Also, arrive early to rehearsals, so we can start on time and end of time. Conflicts need to be discussed with parents prior to rehearsals and written on the back of your audition card at the time of auditions. Be honest! Your focus must be on this show, so once rehearsals have begun, do not commit to another show. Once you have signed onto this show there can be NO conflicts!
